

SAG Awards Are Art-Deco Sleek

The signature rectangular tables at this year's Screen Actors Guild Awards, produced by **Jeff Margolis Productions** in association with SAG, were complemented by an elegant art-deco theme meant to hark back to the time when the New York supper club reined supreme, said **A Wynning Event's Andrea WynSchall**, awards event supervisor. Floral arrangements of white roses, calla lilies and other greens in sleek black boxes

by Culver City, Calif.'s **CJ Matsumoto & Sons** complemented black table linens with silver satin napkins from **Classic Party Rentals** of El Segundo. Classic also provided the china, flatware and Opus-style glassware. To create an open, cool space, the walls, pillars and ceiling of the **Shrine Auditorium's** expo hall were blacked out with fabric, 100,000 square feet of carpet was laid down and three levels of risers (from **Mike Brown Grandstands**) were installed. Guests entered through a tunnel of geometric squares designed by Art Director **Keith Greco**. **Joe Stewart** designed the funky art deco-inspired stage. **EventCredentials** registered and credentialed the 3,000-plus attendees.
