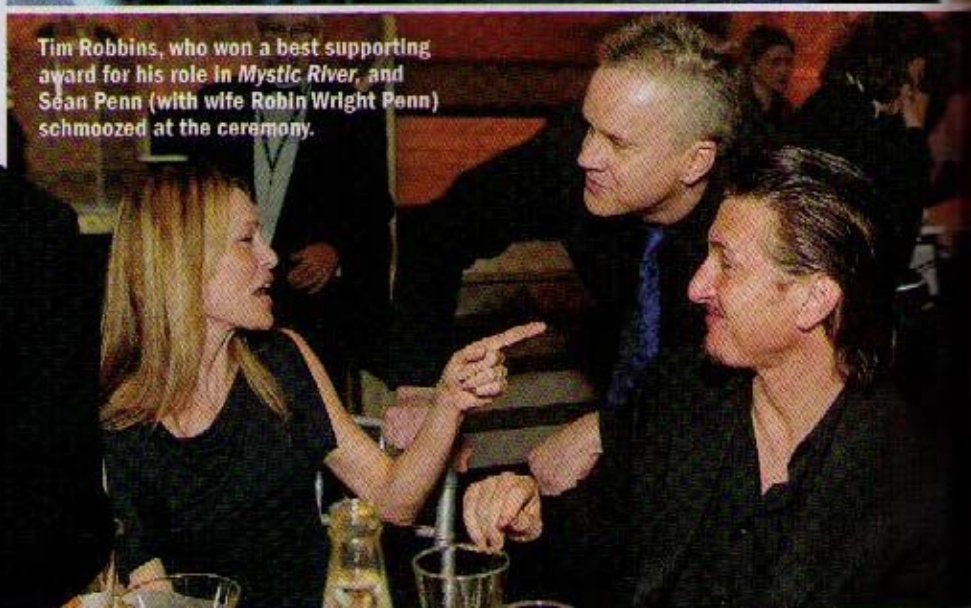
ALL NIGHT LONG

As tender the award, Katie Couric perked up about her son Liana Liberato.



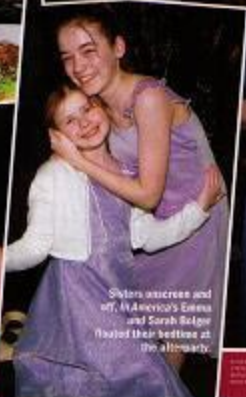
